Global Crossing is an activity organised for the network's members in a country outside Europe. It allows them to get to know new contemporary circus and outdoor arts contexts, markets, to develop collaborative opportunities and exchange knowledge and skills. This activity also provides a basis for members to meet local stakeholders and discover artistic programming.

In 2022, the network is organising an international field trip to New-York (USA) and Montréal (Canada) for its members from July 5th to 15th 2022. Co-organised with TOHU in the frame of the MICC - International Market of Contemporary Circus - and the festival Montréal Complètement Cirque (July 7th-17th), which will celebrate its 12th edition, this trip is meant to connect with the North-American and Canadian contemporary circus and outdoor arts scenes through key visits and meetings.



Travel to United States and Canada

To enter the US, you must fill out the online visa application, which costs \$21 https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/

To enter Canada, you must fill out the <u>Electronic Travel Authorization</u>, which costs \$7 CAD.

Covid restrictions: you must have proof of full vaccination to enter both the US and Canada.

Before entering Canada you must fill out the health their health information through the <u>ArriveCan</u> app.

JFK airport to Manhattan :
