## Transportation in Santiago

#### Subway/ Metro:

Up to this moment, Santiago's subway has 6 lines that connect the city. It works throught a "Bip" card to pay your tickets and you can buy it in any subway station or in a Bip point (there are a lot of these points through Santiago, but the most practical way is to buy it in and charge it in the subway station). The cost of the Bip card is \$1.550 CLP (US\$ 1.87 - 1.74€). Each ticket price varies between \$640 y \$800 CLP (between 0,71€ and 0,89€), depending on the schedule. It can be charged with a minimum \$1.000 CLP (US\$ 1.20 - 1.12€). One ticket price covers 1 subway ride and 1 or 2 bus rides (within the term of 120 minutes). The nearest subway station to Crowne Plaza Hotel is Baquedano station. Universidad Católica station and Parque Bustamante station, are also near to your Hotel.

#### **Bus:**

The bus system in Santiago, Transantiago, also works through the Bip card, under the same pay method. The bus stops vary depending on the sector of the city you are in.

One ticket price covers 1 or 2 bus rides and 1 subway ride (within the term of 120 minutes).

#### **Private Transportation:**

Cab/ Taxi: You can take a Taxi from the street, from any place in the city you are in. You can distinguish them because they are black and yellow. The base rate is \$300 CLP (0,34€) for the first 200 meters ("bajada de bandera" is the chilean expression). Then for every 200 meters or 60 seconds, they add up between \$110 and \$140 CLP (0,12€ and 0,16€), depending on the cab.

Uber: We consider that Uber is safer than a Cab, at least here in our country.

Through your cell phone app, you can ask for a Uber to go to different points of the city. We suggest you consider the driver's score when you ask for your ride. Uber fares vary according to schedules and places.

### Cielos del Infinito

Cielos del Infinito is the southernmost arts festival in the world. Since 2008 it has been held simultaneously in the municipalities of Puerto Williams, Porvenir, Puerto Eden, Puerto Natales, San Gregorio, Cerro Castillo, Cerro Sombrero and Punta Arenas, generating significant experiences that promote encounters, critical and reflective thinking through the exhibition of Theatre, Circus, Dance, Urban Art and Audiovisuals.

It creates and extends cultural spaces to the most extreme areas of the Latin American territory, contributing to the artistic dialogue and the diffusion of creators, through the exhibition of works, seminars, workshops and creative residencies of national and international arts. It has become a pole of cultural interest at regional, national and international level.
