> BANK:

The South African banking network is as well-developed as in Europe. Many local banks, such as Standard, Absa, Nedbank and First National Bank.

- Opening hours: Monday to Friday 9am-3.30pm or 4pm, Saturday 9am-11am (or 8.30am-11.30am).
- ATMs: you'll find them everywhere, in large, medium-sized and small towns. Visa and MasterCard are the 2 most established networks.

Avoid withdrawing money in a deserted corner and be vigilant in large towns. ATMs in the city centre may only be accessible during office hours. In small towns, no problem.

> SECURITY:

Some simple measures to apply:

- Avoid walking alone,
- Don't walk at night.
- Carry only a small amount of money, no ostentatious jewellery and photocopies of identity papers.
- Plan your route, walk or drive towards a specific goal.
- Carry a working cell phone. Memorise rapid access emergency numbers:

- Main emergency: 112

- Police: 10111

Ambulance: 10177

In the event of an attack in the street or in a vehicle

- Stay calm. Above all, don't try to resist.
- Don't make any sudden movements, especially with your hands, which should remain visible, and avoid staring or talking to the aggressor(s).

As far as safety recommendations are concerned, they should never be neglected. perfectly liveable, and there's nothing to fear if you don't take any risks!
