


MAJOR IMPACTS

These results come from a survey^{*} launched by Circostrada Network, with the aim of identifying circus and street arts events that have been either <u>cancelled</u> or <u>postponed</u> due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By collecting and sharing these data, our goal is to better advocate for these sectors and imagine appropriate support measures




In 20% of cases, the events are completely cancelled

In 80% of cases, the events are postponed



But in **64%** of these cases, artistic companies are in **complete uncertainty** because they haven't received yet any confirmation date





*This survey was filled in by over 100 organisations or artistic companies from 25 countries (mostly based in Europe + Taiwan), conducted between March 16th and May 15th 2020.
